**Did you know? There are seven major themed release dates for the dissemination of data from the 2021 Census of Population.**

Each major release of data by theme is highlighted in *The Daily*, Statistics Canada's official release bulletin, and each major release offers data, analytical, and reference products.

**The First Nations people, Métis and Inuit in Canada release is planned for September 2022.**

The Indigenous Peoples Survey (IPS) collects information that is complementary to the Census which is invaluable to support communities.

The IPS focuses on social and economic outcomes related to education, employment, language, health and access to services of First Nations people living off reserve, Métis and Inuit.

**Historical IPS data is available from 1991 to 2017 and soon 2022! Help make this the best year yet.**
